Hill walking (full day) hill walking will take place at Dunkeld and consist of a reasonable standard walk (approx 12 kilometres) from Drambuie Wood up to Loch Ordie returning via Roar Lodge to Drambuie Wood. All walkers require to have walking boots, woolly hat and gloves and waterproof jacket and over trousers.

Overnight Hike & Camp will take place in the Dunkeld starting and finishing at Guay, but will be approx 8 -10 kilometers
All walkers require having hill walking boots, wooly hat and gloves and waterproof jacket and over trousers.

Each day at 4.15pm there will be a "Festival Fringe" on the stage in the Festival Plaza - International Visitors will be invited to perform a song, dance etc from their country and each sub-camp will put on a performance related to their International Festival.
